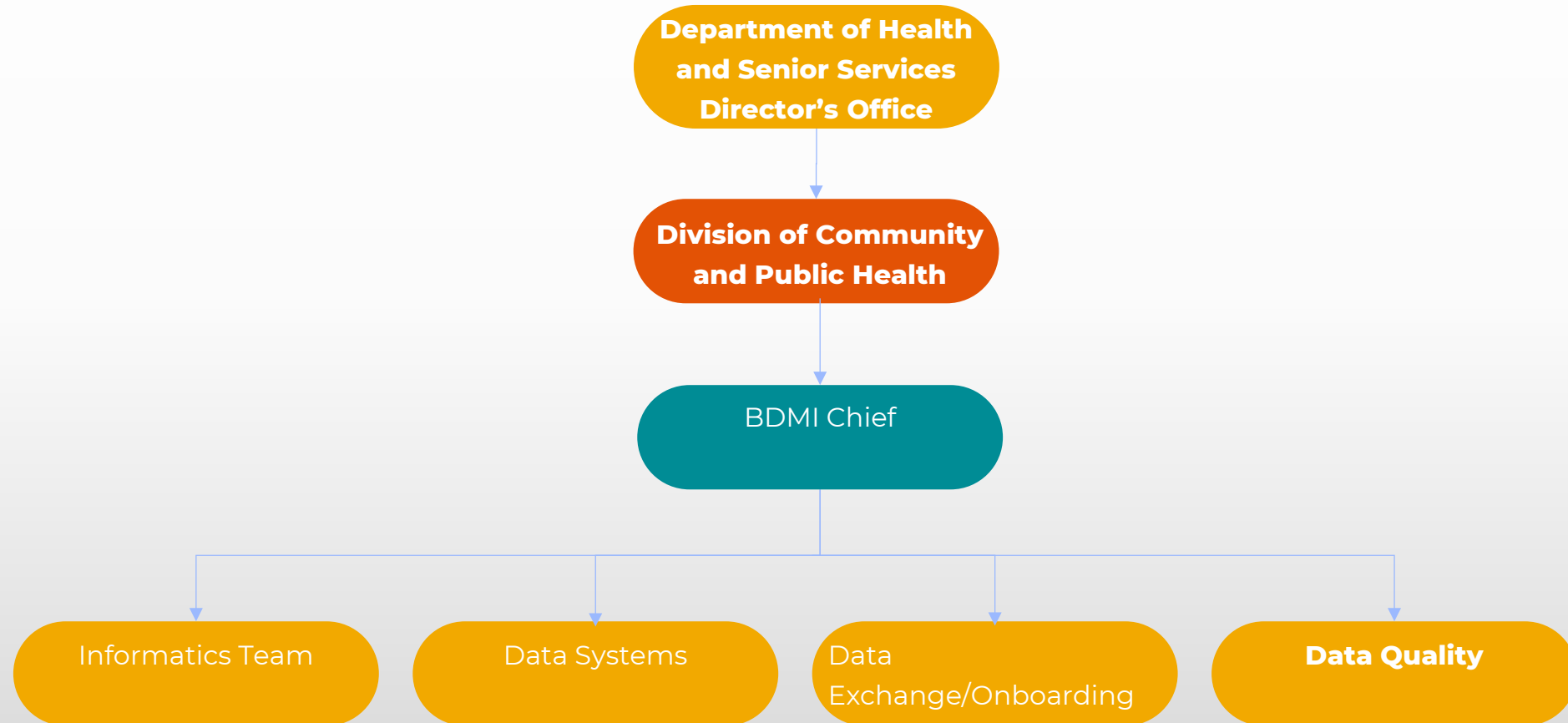

CDC's Data Modernization Initiative (DMI)

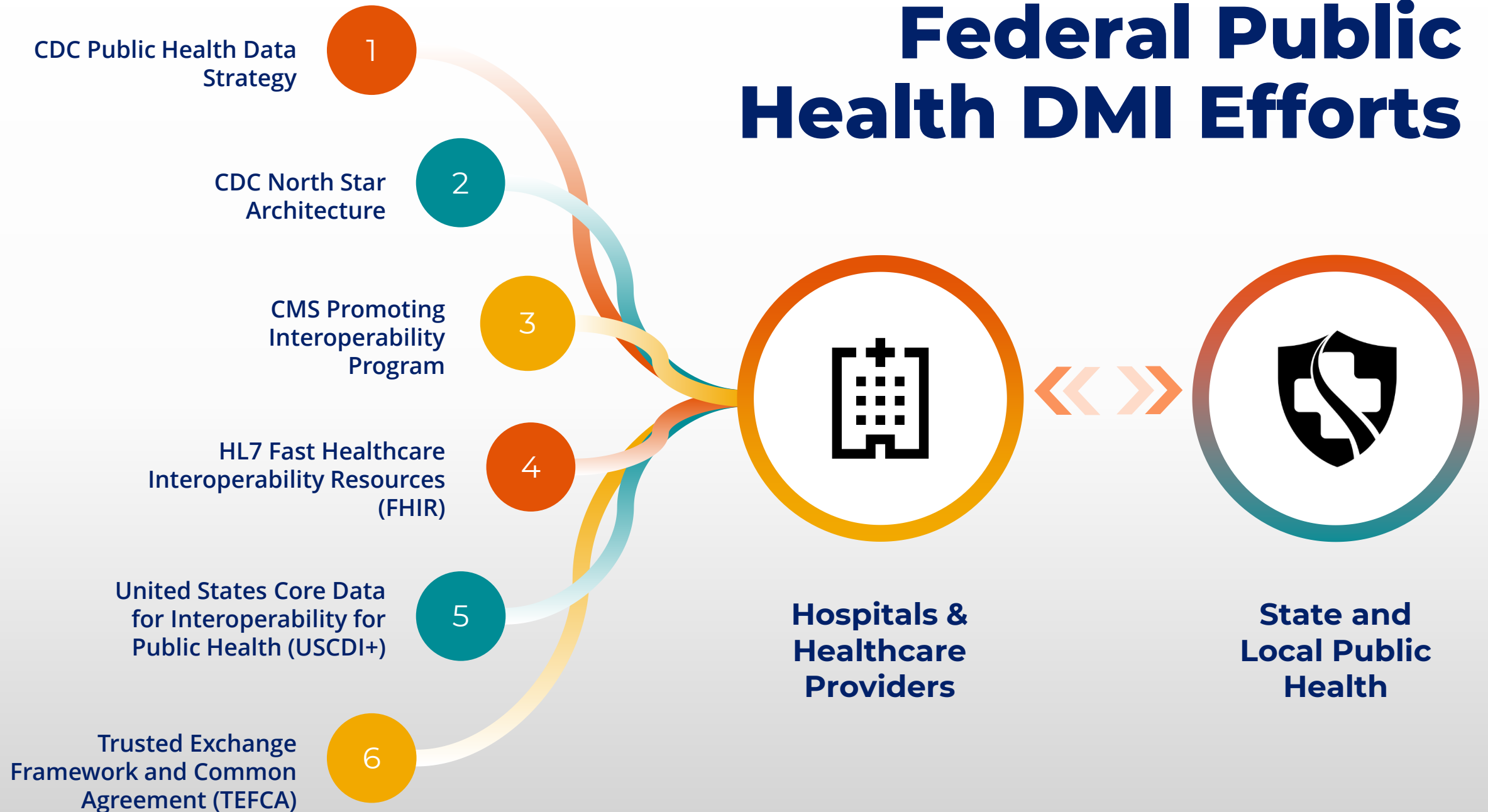
- A multi-year, multi-billion-dollar effort to modernize data across the federal and state public health landscape.
