Asthma -

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hypoallergenic Assistance Program: Members with asthma, who are in care management (CM), can receive two items. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Asthma Waves: Support and tools to control asthma. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Asthma and COPD Relief Catalog: Members with asthma or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) can select one item from a custom catalog.
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Behavioral Health and Therapy -

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Peer Support Specialist Program: Members receive support in person or on the phone for behavioral health (BH) services. • Self Care by AbleTo: Members 13 and older may receive premium access to this app. It helps with stress, anxiety, and other common struggles. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Homer Helps ADHD: Members 12 and under with attention deficit disorder/attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADD/ADHD) can receive an emotional support kit. • Medical Alert Tag: Members who qualify can get an alert tag. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Art Therapy: Members 3+ who are active in behavioral health (BH) case management will receive ten art sessions. Members need to have a certain diagnosis to be eligible. • Equine Therapy: Members 6+ who are active in behavioral health (BH) case management will receive ten equine (horse) sessions. Members need to have a certain diagnosis to be eligible. • Meditation App Subscription: Members age 13+, who qualify, will receive access to a meditation app. • Emotional Well-Being Resources: Members, age 13+, will receive access to the Learn to Live community. It provides tools to cope with emotional health issues.
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Community and Education -

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walmart Plus (+): Members eighteen and over in CM will receive Walmart Plus. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HiSET Exam Voucher Program: Members over the age of 16 can receive one high school equivalency test (HiSET) Exam Voucher per year. • Mobile Texting and ConnectionsPlus Phone Program: High-risk members can receive a cell phone. It allows them to connect with their health care team. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Community Resource Link: Members will have access to the resource link. It provides local benefits and services. • Community Welcome Centers: Members will have access to two centers. They provide health and wellness events and local info. • HiSet Assistance: Members age 16+, who qualify, will receive one code, per year, to cover the high school equivalency test (HiSet). • Tutorial Services: Members aged 11 to 17, who qualify, can receive 24 hours of virtual tutoring.
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Health and Fitness -

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One Pass: Members 18 and older can get a membership to both an online and in-person gym options. Members can search online at One Pass for gyms in their area. • Diabetes Tailored Meals: Members in disease management (DM) with diabetes receive classes and meals. Members will be enrolled in case management (CM) for ongoing care. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Weight Watchers Weight Watchers: Members can be enrolled in weight watchers. • Blood Pressure Program: Members with certain risk factors will receive a blood pressure (BP) cuff. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Healthy Adults Healthy Results - Weight Watchers (WW): Members age 18+, with obesity will receive one WW voucher. • Healthy Adults Healthy Results - Exercise Essentials: Members age 18+, with obesity, can select one of two items. • Healthy Adults Healthy Results - Choose Healthy: Members will have access to Choose Healthy. It offers over 1,000 resource materials. • Fresh Food Connect: Members, age 18+, with diabetes can select one of three items. • Healthy Lifestyle Aids: Members age 18+, with a qualifying diagnosis, can select one item from a list of nine.
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Maternity Support -

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wellhop: Pregnant members who qualify can enroll in the Wellhop App. You are assigned to a centering group with other mothers. You can also meet individually. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maternity Support Bands: Pregnant moms can receive a support band. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mom and Baby Essentials: Members who qualify will receive a \$100 gift card. They will use it to purchase items supporting a healthy pregnancy.
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<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mom's Meals: Members who deliver a baby may get 30 healthy balanced meals (2 per day). The meals are delivered to the member's home after they are discharged from the hospital. • Baby Items: Members can get one item, either a Pack N' Play or a car seat, before or after birth. • Baby Showers and Breastfeeding Events: Members will have access to showers and events and receive supplies. • Electronic Breast Pumps: Enrolled pregnant members are eligible for an electronic breast pump (limit one). • Maternal Comfort Supplies: Members can select from items such as a belly band and compression socks. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mom's Meals Services: Members who deliver a baby may get 30 days of home meals. The meals are delivered to the member's home after they are released from the hospital. Members who did not just have a baby, but have a health condition, may also qualify. • Baby Showers for Moms: Moms to be can receive baby showers. • Breast Pump and Supplies: Pregnant members can get a double electric breast pump. Those within 30 days of delivery of up to 6 months after. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Home Delivered Meals: Members who delivered a baby, within the past two weeks, will get 14 meals. The meals are delivered to the member's home 14-20 days after discharge. • Breast Pump: Members who qualify can receive a breast pump every 24 months.
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Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) -

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enhanced Transportation Program: Members with NEMT (non-emergency medical transportation) as a covered benefit can get rides to places not covered by NEMT. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enhanced Transportation Services Program: Members with non-emergency medical transportation (NEMT) as a covered benefit can get rides to places not covered by NEMT. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT): Members with NEMT as a covered benefit can get rides to places not covered by NEMT.
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Youth Club -

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • YMCA Membership: Members 17 and younger can obtain a YMCA membership. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Youth Club Membership: Members aged 5-17, who completed a Well Visit, will receive a \$30 gift card. They will use it toward membership fees at a youth club.
