The Gap Analysis estimates state investment needs for full foundational public health services implementation.

Important Timelines

FY2025 training starts January 2026 with a May 1 data submission¹ deadline and final report due December 2026.

Early Reporting¹

Agencies with non-calendar fiscal years are encouraged to start the FY2025 Gap Analysis early to ensure timely and accurate reporting.

Confirm Point of Contact


Agencies should verify and update their primary contact to ensure timely communication and resource access.
