Local public health agencies (LPHAs) address a wide range of public health issues, from assessing the health risks of environmental problems to providing emergency services during natural disasters. Reach out to your local public health agency for these services in your area:

- WIC
- Vaccines
- Food/health inspections
- Blood lead testing
- Private well water testing
- Sports physicals

Helping citizens find their local public health agency is important.

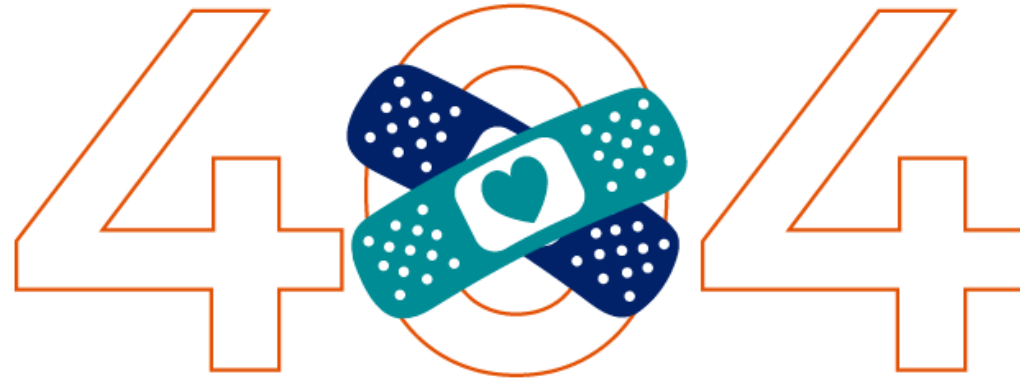


What To Expect After Launch



Changing URLs, Redirects and Old Content

- Some web page URLs will change immediately at launch and redirects will be in place.
- You will need to clear your “cookies” on your web browsers. (You can check with your IT department.)
- You will need to re-bookmark your favorite web pages.
- Most links will continue to work without interruption.
 - Smart redirects will automatically send users from an old link to the corresponding new link
 - Smart 404 “Page Not Found” will appear for pages that do not have a direct replacement or alternative piece of content
